- Spend HK\$4 billion (US\$510 million) to expand the Science Park
- Launch two pilot projects establishing high-efficiency multi-storey buildings to promote smart production

Promoting Research and Development (R&D)



- Launch new Midstream Research
 Programme for universities to carry
 out midstream and applied research
 projects
- Increase cash rebate to encourage SMEs to invest in R&D
- Extend the Public Sector Trial Scheme to promote the realisation and commercialisation of R&D results

Supporting I&T Start-ups



- Launch new Innovation and Technology Venture Fund to co-invest with private venture capital funds in local technology start-ups
- Cyberport to enhance support to startups

Nurturing Talents



- Launch the Enriched IT Programme in Secondary schools offering intensive training to students possessing good potential

- Increase community-wide free Wi-fi hotspots from 17 000 to 34 000
- Launch new "Innovation and Technology Fund for Better Living" to encourage innovative ideas with practical application in improving our daily living
