of action towards productive diversification

- 1. Implementing sectoral working groups to facilitate the emergence of new drivers of growth.
- 2. Non financial tools to enhance productivity of MSMEs.
- 3. Developing tools and incentives to boost productive innovation.
- 4. Financial tools to increase MSMEs productivity.
- 5. Setting up the National Institute of Quality and strengthening the quality infrastructure to improve productivity in the private sector.
- 6. Development and promotion of modern industrial parks.



PRODUCTIVE INNOVATION

Peru is presently incentivizing innovation in two new ways:

- A. With tax breaks for R&D spending, enacted in 2015 and to be put into practice this year.
- B. With larger competitive funding, less red tape and a greater emphasis on productive development and innovative ecosystem strengthening policies.

A. R&D Tax Incentives

Deduction to R&D+i from Jan. 1, 2016

PROJECTS:

SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

TECHNOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENT

TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATION

Developed directly by an enterprise or through an authorized R + D + i

Projects must be qualified and businesses / authorized centers.
Fast and safe procedure

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




























































- Startup Perú has also developed a support line for strengthening business incubators.
